Dr. Cai served as a board member of the Acupuncture Committee of Alberta, Canada, from 2003 to 2005. He was also the Dean of Academic Affairs at Alberta College of Acupuncture and Traditional Chinese Medicine, between 1997 and 2005. Cai passed the American and Canadian medical licensing examinations and was certified as an M.D. in 1997 and 1999, respectively. Cai joined the faculty of the Texas Health and Science University in January 2006. Cai has been the Academic Dean since 2008 and become VP of Academics in 2023. Dr. Cai was also certified as a Diplomate of Oriental Medicine by NCCAOM in 2009.
